



Contest Rules & Regulations

Contest Sponsors

The Canada Cares Awards contest (the “Contest”) is sponsored by Canada Cares, a program of Canadian Abilities Foundation, and BCS Communications Ltd. (the “Sponsors”) No purchase is necessary to enter the Contest.

Eligibility

This Contest is open to all legal residents of Canada who are at least 21 years old. Employees of Sponsors and of distributors, wholesalers, retailers, subsidiaries, affiliates of Sponsors, and of related companies or agencies or the independent contest organization, and those with whom such employees are domiciled are not eligible.

How to Enter

Contest entries will be collected between Tuesday, April 7th, 2020 and Friday, September 25th, 2020 (the “Contest Period”). Limit of one (1) entry per person during the Contest Period.

The Contest closes on Friday September 25th at 6:00 pm EST.

Winner Selection

Entries received before the Contest closing date will be reviewed by a committee, the members of which will select 10 to 15 outstanding Canadian family caregivers and professional caregivers for recognition by the Sponsors. In addition, the committee will select one or more caregivers to receive a Canada Cares One Wish Award of up to \$10,000. Winners will be selected within 30 days of the Contest closing date and notified by email no later than 5 business days after winner selection.

One Wish Award

At the sole discretion of the Sponsors, the \$10,000 One Wish Award may be awarded in full to one winner or proportionately to two or more winners (excluding Quebec residents).

Sponsors reserve the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value in the event that the cash award is unavailable for any reason. The One Wish Award must be accepted as awarded and is non-transferable.

Odds of Winning

The odds of winning a caregiver recognition award and One Wish Award depend upon the number of eligible entries submitted to the Contest and on the quality and completeness of your entry.

Note: Quebec residents are not eligible for the One Wish Award.
